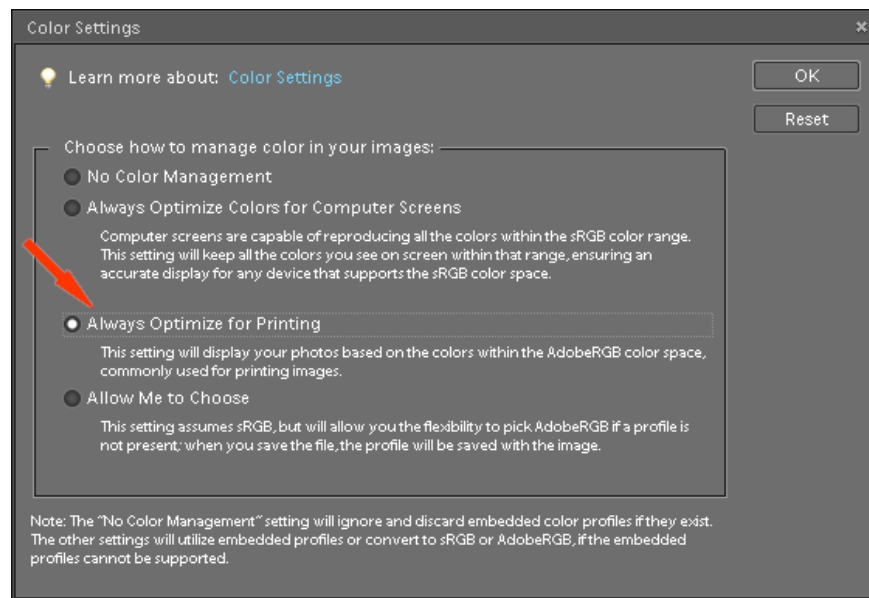


Configuring Photoshop Elements 6 Color Settings for Use with Sublimation on EPSON B40W

Photoshop's color space needs to be set to the working space of which the Sublimation ICC Profile was created. This then allows for a more accurate screen display of your images. The accuracy of the displayed image on your monitor will highly be dependent on the quality of your monitor and more important a calibrated monitor ICC profile. Photoshop's Adobe Gamma will allow you to calibrate and save an ICC profile for your monitor.

Start Photoshop Elements 6 and bring up the color settings window by clicking **Edit → Color Settings**.



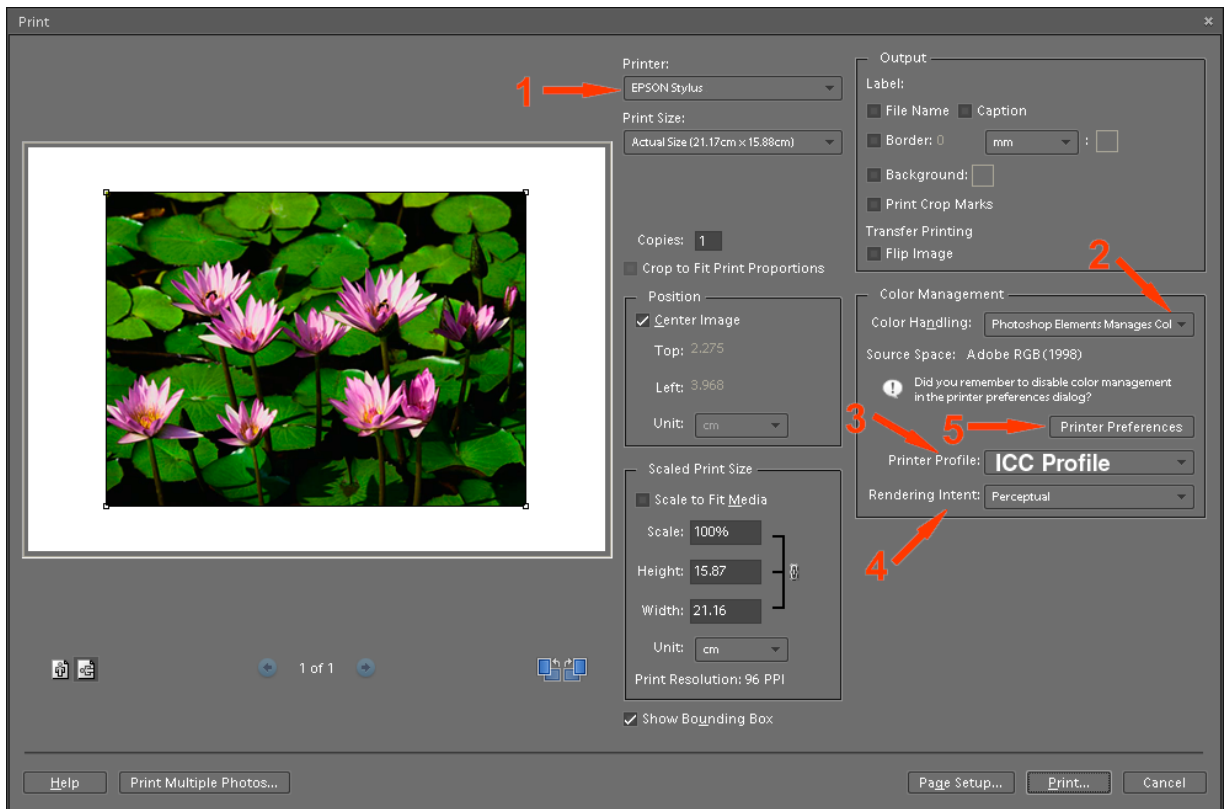
Ensure that **'Always Optimize for Printing'** is selected and click **'OK'**

Photoshop Elements RGB working space is now set and adobe gamma is controlling your monitor profile.

You can now work on your images as normal. Follow the subsequent steps for printing using the Sublimation ICC profile.

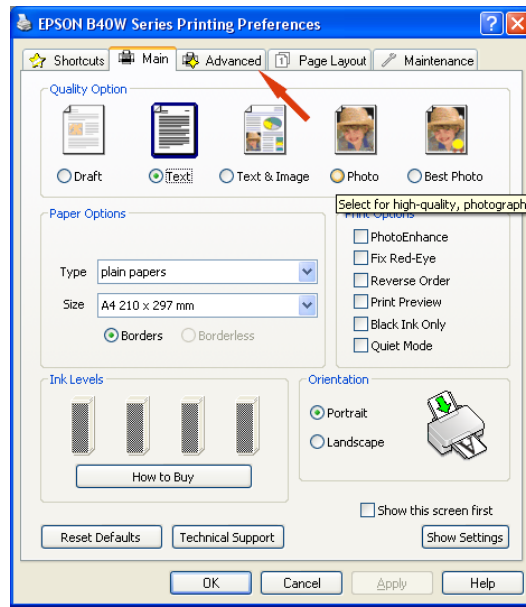
Printing with the B40W Sublimation ICC Profile in Photoshop Elements 6

When your image is ready to print open the print preview dialogue, Click **File → Print**

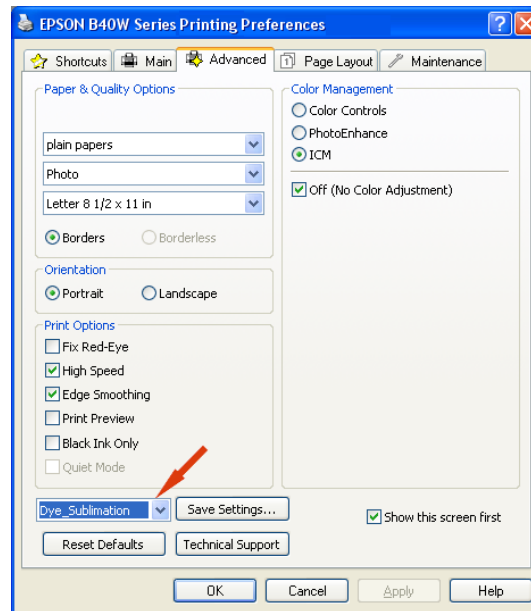


- 1 Select the '**EPSON Stylus B40W Series**' printer from the drop down box indicated at point 1.
- 2 At '**Color Handling**' select '**Photoshop Elements Manages Color**' from the drop menu indicated at point 2.
- 3 At '**Printer Profile**' select the '**Sublimation ICC Profile** indicated at point 3.
- 4 At '**Rendering Intent**' select '**Perceptual**' indicated at point 4.
- 5 Click '**Printer Preferences**' indicated at point 5 to open the printer preferences dialogue as shown below.

Note: If you don't see any reference to Sublimation RGB profile in the print space list means the ICC profile is not installed in your system or Photoshop has not been restarted since the profile was installed, this will require you to restart Photoshop.



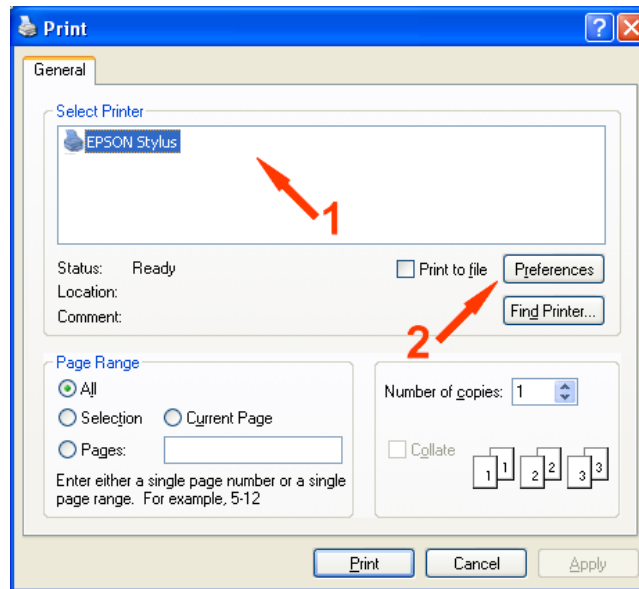
- 1 Click the '**Advanced**' tab to open the advanced printer settings.



- 1 Select the preset driver settings that have already been created from the drop down menu indicated at point 1.

Click '**OK**' to return to the print preview dialogue.

Click **'Print'** in the print preview dialogue box and the **'Print'** dialogue will open as shown below.



- 1 Select the **'EPSON Stylus B40W Series'** printer from the menu indicated at point 1.

Click **'Print'** and the image will be sent to the printer.
